### Admission Guidelines

Students can apply to the college from the college website ([www.dbcyelagiri.edu.in](http://www.dbcyelagiri.edu.in)). On paying the application fee online with basic details, the application is accepted. Login Detail (User Id and Password) with the next procedure to follow (ie Provisional Selection, Submission of documents and Confirmation of the Admission) is given to the candidate via email and SMS.

1. The selected candidates are communicated by SMS/Telecall for personal interview and to confirm admission.
2. Certificates to be produced at the time of admission are:
  - a. Transfer Certificate (original)
  - b. SSLC Certificate (original)
  - c. Higher Secondary Certificate or equivalent(original) with 4 photocopies (for UG). For PG, provisional certificate and consolidated mark statement
  - d. Community Certificate (original), with 4 photocopies
  - e. Income Certificate (Obtained after April, 2023 and original) with 4 photocopies

- f. Attendance Certificate from the school last studied for UG Students if scholarship is required
- g. 4 copies of Student Photograph of recent passport size
- h. Aadhar Card (Photocopy)
- i. Photocopy of First Page of Bank Passbook with IFSC and MICR Code (Student Account)
- j. Eligibility Certificate from Thiruvalluvar University (original), *if not qualified from Tamilnadu Higher Secondary Examination Board or Thiruvalluvar University*
- k. Disability Certificate (original for physically challenged candidates)

3. Moovalur Ramamiritham (**Pudhumai Penn**) Ammaiyar Higher Education Assurance scheme for girls (Those who studied Tamil & English medium from class 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Standard in government school).
4. Fr Guezou Education Scholarship for the economically disadvantaged students by the Management with the support of alumni and friends of Don Bosco.

## Student Residences

1. The College has four hostels namely:
  - a) Papa Duhayon Hostels (for UG/PG Boys)
  - b) Ennagam Hostel/Joachim Villa (for UG Boys)
  - c) Jolarpettai Hostel (for UG Boys)
  - d) Arockia Annai Hostel (for UG Girls)
  - e) Mother Teresa Hostel (for PG Girls)
2. Hostel facility is given only after admission in the College, paying the hostel establishment and maintenance fee.  
 Establishment Fee per Semester : Rs 5000  
 Maintenance Fee per Annum : Rs 2000
3. Hostel Students have regular food in Savio Mess. Each Student pays a monthly fee of Rs 1700\*\* for Boys and Rs 1600\*\* for Girls). This amount is directly collected by Savio Mess. Those students who are unable to pay the mess fee, due to the economic situation may seek partial assistance through the Fr Guezou Service Scholarship.

## General Norms

1. Admission to the College is not a guarantee for the degree. The student must apply serious and sustained hard-work, respecting the faculty members and College regulations, making the optimal use of the facilities offered for holistic development.
2. Any student who is admitted to a program must pay the prescribed fee for the entire academic year
3. The campus language is English. All staff and students are expected to converse and correspond only in English within the campus.
4. Any abuse of mobile phones in the campus is treated with severe corrective measures.
5. Attendance is compulsory. Those who fail to get a minimum of 75% attendance cannot appear for semester examinations.
6. Students maintain a sense of decorum and discipline inside the College and in public places.
7. Any student who engages in smoking, drinking, drug trafficking, ragging or unwanted relationship with an opposite gender will be subjected to enquiry by the DBCY Discipline Committee and be warned, suspended or dismissed by the Board of Management based on the gravity of the matter and recommendation of the Committee.
8. Students are to wear their identity cards certified up-to-date, at all times and produce them to the duly appointed security guards on duty at the gates for entry and exit.
9. College office must be kept informed of the change of address and phone numbers.
10. The College expects parents or guardians to cooperate with the college authorities in the education of their children/wards. They should follow the students' progress in studies and his/her general conduct in and outside the college. Their cooperation is solicited specially to ensure regular attendance. They are expected to come and meet whenever they are called by the Principal or the respective Head of the Department.
11. Students shall keep the photo copies of their certificates before submitting the originals to the office. Requisition for original certificates once submitted in the office will not be entertained.
12. Day-scholars from the plains should commute only by the College Bus and two-wheelers are strictly prohibited. All those who avail college transport facility should pay the total fee per the year even if someone withdraws during the year.
13. A student cannot organize or participate in any association or registered body without the explicit permission of the Principal.
14. No collection of funds for any reason is allowed on the premises without the approval of the Principal.
15. Any damage to College must be compensated by the wrongdoers.
16. A student who has enrolled for a programme of study is expected to complete the same. She/he should not withdraw from the college without informing the Principal in writing. Otherwise, he/she will be liable to pay the fees for the period his/her name remains on the roll. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
