

Admission Guidelines





Documents to be Submitted at the Time of Admission


The **four (4) photocopies** of the following I certificates (Transfer Certificate in original) must be submitted during admission: All original documents will be verified at the time of admission.

Hostel Admission and Fees

Hostel admission is granted only after successful admission to a college program. Students must pay the following fees:

Establishment Fee (per semester): ₹6,000 Maintenance Fee (per annum): ₹4,000

Mess Facility

All hostel residents have access to regular meals at the Savio Mess. Monthly mess fees are:

Boys: ₹1,900/month

Girls: ₹1,800/month

Mess fees are collected directly by Savio Mess. Economically disadvantaged students may apply for partial

financial assistance through the Management Scholarship scheme.

General Norms and Code of Conduct

Admission to the college does not guarantee the award of a degree. Students are expected to demonstrate consistent academic commitment, adhere to institutional policies, respect faculty and staff, and make optimal use of college resources for their intellectual, personal, and professional growth.

English is the official language of communication on campus. All students and faculty members are expected to converse and correspond strictly in English to maintain a professional academic environment.

A minimum of 75% attendance in each subject is mandatory to be eligible for semester-end examinations. Students falling short of this requirement will not be permitted to appear for exams under any circumstance.

Acts of smoking, consumption of alcohol, possession or trafficking of drugs, ragging, or involvement in inappropriate interpersonal relationships are strictly forbidden. Violations will be reviewed by the DBCY Discipline Committee and may result in a warning, suspension, or dismissal, subject to the severity and recommendation of the committee and final decision of the Board of Management.

Any change in a student's address or contact number must be promptly communicated to the college office to ensure effective communication.

Day-scholars from the plains are required to use the college transport facility. Use of two-wheelers is strictly prohibited. Once enrolled for college transport, the full transport fee for the academic year must be paid, even in the event of mid-year withdrawal.

Students who wish to discontinue their studies must formally

Upon admission to any academic program, students are required to pay the full prescribed fee for the entire academic year, irrespective of any discontinuation during the course of study.

The misuse or abuse of mobile phones on campus will attract strict disciplinary action. Students are expected to use mobile devices responsibly and only in designated areas, if permitted.

Students are expected to uphold high standards of decorum and discipline both on campus and in public. Courteous behavior, respectful interaction, and adherence to institutional values are compulsory at all times.

Students must wear their updated and college-certified identity cards at all times on campus. Entry and exit are permitted only upon presenting the ID card to security personnel stationed at the gates.

The college seeks the active cooperation of parents or guardians in supporting the academic and personal development of their wards. They are encouraged to monitor their ward's progress and are expected to respond to communication from the Principal or Heads of Departments when requested.

Students shall not form or participate in any association, club, or external registered body without prior written approval from the Principal. Collection of funds on campus for any reason must also be approved by the Principal in advance.
